The East San Gabriel Valley Regional Occupational Program is providing summer school courses for its partnering districts Azusa USD, Baldwin Park USD, Charter Oak USD, Glendora USD, Walnut USD, and West Covina USD. Space is limited. **Application for a summer school class does not guarantee enrollment. Low enrollment may result in cancellation of class at any time. Students must be enrolled in one of the JPA partner districts for the 21-22 school year to be eligible.**

1st Day Policy	Attendance begins on June 14, 2021, the first day of summer school for ESGVROP. Due to the rigor of summer courses, <u>perfect attendance is recommended.</u>
Attendance Policy	Each year-long course meets for 120 hours and students must be in attendance for a minimum of 110 hours to receive credit. Tardies will be subtracted against the hours of attendance in 30 minute increments. Tardies and absences will be combined to determine if a student has met the minimum number of hours to receive credit for the course. Students may be dropped from summer school when they accumulate tardies and absence that exceed 10 hours for 120 hours courses.
Credits	A year-long class meets 24 days for 5 hours: student passing the class earn 10 credits.
Discipline	The privilege to attend summer school depends on continued appropriate school and classroom behavior. Parents will be contacted and students will be dropped from summer school for disruptive or inappropriate behavior. Students may be dropped for any violation of Education Code 48900.
Dress Code	The district dress code will be enforced.
